Good day Cunningham families,

I hope this letter finds you and your family doing well. Today, the Chancellor announced that Junior High School buildings will reopen for in-person instruction on Thursday, February 25, 2021. Thursday, February 25, 2021 will be a 'Day 3-Cohort B' in-person session. All students who are in-person learners must return the consent to test for COVID form. Any family who fails to return or refuses to allow their child(ren) to be tested will automatically be switched over to remote instruction for the remainder of the school year. Below is the hyperlink for the COVID consent form if you have not completed it yet. A reminder, that all in-person students must provide daily COVID screeners prior to entering the school building. This can be done two (2) ways:

1. Complete screening online the morning of the test and show "confirmation" via cell phone: <https://healthscreening.schools.nyc/>
2. Complete paper copy: [NYC DOE Health Screening Questionnaire](#)

As in October, all students will show their COVID screener, enter the school yard and will enter the school building through the back ramp. All students will be dismissed from the school yard at the conclusion of the day. All in-person students must have an updated blue card on file for emergency and COVID purposes. **Reminder on Out of State Travel:** As a friendly reminder, students who have recently traveled outside of New York to a place on the State's travel advisory list must quarantine for 10 days or test out of the 10-day quarantine based on the State's guidance, which can be found [here](#).
